The submission deadline is June 1<sup>st</sup>, 2010.

By subject of the Academy Conference, different papers can be presented:

1. Diagnostic procedures in joint hypermobility and related conditions. Reliability studies are the most important. Furthermore, validity, specificity and sensitivity studies
2. Motion analysis studies
3. Biomechanics with relevance for diagnosis
4. Neurophysiology with relevance for diagnosis
5. Also preliminary results of efficacy studies can be discussed.
6. Proposals for protocols can be presented for discussion
7. Reviewed articles

Oral presentations: 10 minutes + 5 minutes discussion  
In the presentation as well as the abstracts (max 250 words) the following headers have to be used:

- a. Purpose of the study
- b. Material and Methods
- c. Results
- d. Conclusions

Also those who presents an abstract have to pay the registration fee (350 €).
